Event 24: Sub 600 Air Rifle

General

This event will be a standing (as defined in IMSSU rules) event. The rifle will conform to the following rules:

- Production "off the shelve" rifle
- · Any open or aperture sights will be allowed.
- No optical devices will be allowed.
- Any safe trigger will be allowed.
- Aftermarket sights are <u>allowed</u>
- Limited to velocity of 600 fps
- Caliber .177 (4.5mm) maximum weight 10.4gr

The IMSSU defined Air Rifle targets will be used. The targets will be set at the following distances:

 Pigs
 12 meters

 15 meters
